Course Content

- How to identify the properties of asbestos and outline the history of its use
- Understanding the health effects of asbestos
- Outline of the types, uses and likely occurrence of asbestos and asbestos containing materials (ACMs) in buildings
- Identification of the main statutory provisions that relate to asbestos
- Know what correct procedures to follow in an emergency.
- Know how to avoid the risks of asbestos

The training will be assessed through a combination of in-course questioning as well as via the practical exercises and a short multi-choice exam at the end of the day.
